

Kids need to be healthy to learn!

The Kid Clinic is a school-based pediatric clinic for Campbell County students in pre-kindergarten through 12th grade and their siblings over age 2. Located in the Ready 4 Learning Building across from St. Matthew's Catholic Church, the Kid Clinic is open Monday-Friday from 8 am - 5 pm. The Kid Clinic is a collaborative effort between Campbell County Health and Campbell County School District to provide primary medical care, behavioral health and substance abuse counseling services. No child is denied services based on ability to pay.



Appointments

A parent or guardian must be present at the first appointment to access the Kid Clinic and sign required consent forms. Follow-up appointments do not require a parent or guardian to be present, and the child can be transported from their school to the Kid Clinic using school district transportation if the child becomes ill while at school. School nurses and counselors are an important part of the referral process, and can identify students who can benefit from the services of the Kid Clinic. Walk-ins are accepted, but patients with appointments receive first priority. Behavioral health appointments are coordinated through the school counselor.



The Kid Clinic accepts private insurance, Equality Care/Medicaid and KidCare/CHP. No child is denied services based solely on inability to pay.

Services

The Kid Clinic provides primary medical care by a physician or advanced practitioner. The clinic sees patients with immediate needs, such as strep throat or the flu and does follow-up care as needed for ongoing treatment. The Kid Clinic helps parents establish a relationship for regular check-ups and ongoing healthcare for their children. Counseling services are provided by licensed counselors and social workers for a variety of issues, such as depression, anxiety, substance abuse, divorce or parenting concerns.

As part of Campbell County Health, the Kid Clinic is a member of a healthcare system made up of Campbell County Memorial Hospital and Campbell County Medical Group.
