CONSENT AGENDA ENDS

School Psychologist Salary Schedule Mr. Reznicek reviewed information regarding the licensed personnel salary schedule and recommended moving school psychologists to that schedule which he explained would help in recruitment and retention. Dr. Fall moved to approve, Mrs. Hepp seconded, and the motion carried.

Changes to Policy 4116, Retire-Rehire

Mr. Reznicek pointed out unintended consequences as a result of PPACA in which a "look back" period could make a temporary employee eligible for full benefits at district expense under certain conditions. Mr. Reznicek recommended a changes to the policy to address the issue. Dr. Fall made a motion to approve, Mrs. Durgin seconded, and the motion carried.

Recess for Public Hearing

Mrs. Jennings recessed the regular meeting at 7:15 p.m. to hold a public hearing regarding the budget amendment. Following Dr. Ayers review of the proposed amendment and there being no public input, the regular meeting was reconvened at 7:20 p.m.

Approval of Budget Amendment Dr. Fall moved to approve the budget amendment as follows, Mrs. Shippy seconded, and the motion carried.

WHEREAS Campbell County School District Number One is a nonprofit political subdivision of the State of Wyoming formed to provide public education in grades K-12 for persons residing within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the General Fund 01 in the amount of \$21,000.00 to account for potential operating transfers to the Nutrition Services Fund for a potential cash shortfall;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to adjust the General Fund 01 in the amount of \$1,080,417.69 to account for the underfunding of recapture and increase various revenue accounts to more accurately reflect projected General Fund revenue;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Nutrition Service Fund in the amount of \$27,069.55 to account for an operating transfer from General Fund 01 for the hot/cold transport units; account for the Child and Adult Care Food Program; and additional Fresh Fruit and Vegetable programs; and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to adjust all General Funds to account for budget journal entries during the fiscal year, account for the operating transfers to Nutrition Services Fund 50 for the hot/cold units and to the Grant Special Revenue Fund 20 for the Substance Abuse & Mental Health Ellbogen match; and to adjust contingency accounts to meet the needs of the District. BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees, Campbell County School District Number One, Gillette, Wyoming, this 10th day of June, 2014, hereby approves the budget amendment as stated above.

Comments from Trustees

Dr. Fall said the trustees enjoyed their visit and meal at the Campbell County Children's Developmental Center earlier in the evening.

Mrs. Hepp made a motion to recess for executive session to discuss personnel. Dr. Fall seconded, and the motion carried. The meeting recessed at 7:22 p.m. and reconvened at 8:05 p.m.
