Accreditation Review

Mr. Eisenhaer provided an accreditation review. The WDE oversees the process, and the purpose is to ensure the District complies with all state requirements. A peer review is an additional process and is required every five years. The accreditation team includes members outside our District who visit schools, look at our processes, and speak with staff and students. The District is scheduled in mid-October for the review.

Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) Campbell County High School Principal Chad Bourgeois and Executive Board Member for the Campbell County Veterans Council, Mr. Denton Knapp, updated the board on the potential of offering a Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) program. The academic program would be part of the traditional curriculum and be offered as an elective for all secondary students, requiring two additional certified staff members, supply costs, square footage/acreage for drills, and a minimum of 100 attendees. There are many benefits, including offering students post-secondary and future career opportunities.

**Facility Update** 

Mr. Bartlett provided a facility update and reviewed the projects completed over the summer. Mr. Bartlett shared an update from the recent School Facilities Commission meeting and the information provided by the District at the meeting on facilities in dire need of repair. He also provided information to the Board on Chapter 3, Section 8, as an avenue to seek funding for condition issues at Campbell County High School and the Transportation Department. After discussion with the board, Mrs. Durgin made a motion to declare Campbell County High School and the Transportation facilities as inadequate as the conditions impede the delivery of their required programs. Dr. Lawrence seconded the motion. The motion carried with five board members voting "yes." Dr. Hallinan did not vote.

**Public Comments** 

Public Comments: Board members are equal and represent the public, process of questions to the board, CCHS sewer bid concerns, transparency is important, the board is the best they have ever worked with and appreciates the transparency, appreciation of the board retreat with the district leadership team, blessed to be a staff member.

**Trustee Celebrations** 

Chairman Ochs celebrated Campbell County High School being open and the water running through the pipes; the Board is working hard with the state to remedy the situation and will continue to do so. Chairman Ochs thanked Dr. Ayers, Mr. Eisenhauer, Mr. Bartlett, Dr. Reznicek, Campbell County High School Principal Chad Bourgeois, and Maintenance Supervisor Sean Mathes for working with the team to make sure the building was open because the student's quality of education comes first!
