Valedictorian distinction will require a 4.000 Class Rank GPA and completing two AP courses. Salutatorian distinction will require a 3.900 Class Rank GPA and completing one AP course. CCHS will publish a date during the second semester of the senior year in which Class Rank calculations will be determined.

Thunder Basin High School (TBHS)

Valedictorian distinction will require a 4.000 Class Rank GPA and completing two AP courses. Salutatorian distinction will require a 3.900 Class Rank GPA and completing one AP course. TBHS will publish a date during the second semester of the senior year in which Class Rank calculations will be determined.

Wright Junior-Senior High School (WJSH)

Valedictorian and Salutatorian will be awarded to the two senior students with the highest Class Rank GPA's. at the close of the 1st semester of their senior year WJSH will publish a date during the second semester of the senior year in which Class Rank calculations will be determined.

Westwood High School

Valedictorian and Salutatorian honors are not determined. Class Rank grade point average will be determined as per District policy.
