- Promote change to workplace policies and environments that promote and support employees in being more physically active, having access to healthier food, avoiding tobacco and managing stress.
- Provide programs and activities at the workplace that offer employees increased opportunities to be physically active, eat healthier food, stop using tobacco and manage stress.
- Support "Healthy Schools" initiatives by striving to model healthy lifestyles choices.
- Elicit ongoing employee feedback through our wellness committee representatives to plan and implement programs that meet the needs and interests of employees.
