

## 4285 Supervision of Student Behavior

Every District ~~employee~~ ~~staff member~~ has the responsibility to assist in the overall supervision of student behavior. It is the staff member's duty to enforce ~~school district~~ policy, administrative regulations and generally accepted discipline measures. ~~, not only in his/her~~ **This includes** classrooms, or assigned areas, ~~but also in~~ other areas of school property, and at school activities.

When a District ~~employee~~ ~~staff member~~ deems it necessary, ~~they~~ ~~that staff member~~ may use such physical force as may be reasonable and necessary to restrain or control a student, to exclude or remove a student from a classroom, school area, or school activity, or to escort a student to the principal's office or other appropriate area when:

- The student, by ~~their~~ ~~his or her~~ words or actions, is threatening or endangering himself or herself, other students, or District staff;
- The student refuses to cooperate and comply with the reasonable direction of ~~an employee.~~ ~~a staff member;~~

In any circumstances, a District staff member shall have the right of self-defense.
