

5105-R At-Risk Students

The District has determined at-risk areas will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Substance abuse (Drugs and alcohol),
- Teen pregnancy,
- Suicide and suicidal ideation,
- Mental health issues,
- Dropping out,
- Illiteracy,
- Involvement with the legal system,
- Victims of violence, and
- Homelessness.

Procedures and resources to be used for identification of "at-risk" students will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Teacher referral,
- Counselor recommendation,
- Parent recommendation,
- Administration referral,
- Student self-referral,
- Outside governmental agencies,
- Child Protection Team (Department of Family Services),
- Single Point of Entry (County Attorney's Office and Juvenile Probation),
- Academic and confidential records, and
- Referrals for suicide intervention.
