

5128 - Rules and Regulations for Students Transported in School Buses

Riding in a school district vehicle is a privilege. Student misconduct which jeopardizes the safe operation of the school bus, or the safety of passengers, may result in the student being denied the privilege of riding in a school district vehicle.

Authority on the school bus lies with the bus driver who will determine when the bus may be safely operated and will enforce rules and regulations regarding acceptable student behavior.

The superintendent, in consultation with the supervisor of transportation, will formulate rules and regulations for acceptable student behavior on school buses and will outline a discipline procedure.
