

5145 Law Enforcement Officers in the School

Campbell County School District recognizes that maintaining a safe learning environment is a necessary component in the educational process. The District will make every effort to cooperate with law enforcement officers in a manner helpful to law enforcement agencies and least disruptive to the educational process. The District shall encourage and promote the use of school resource officers to assist administration in maintaining a safe learning environment.

The District has legal custody of students during the school day and during the hours of approved extra-curricular activities. Law enforcement officers have ample opportunities to talk to students away from school and before or after school hours. It is the preference of the District that contacts between law enforcement officers and students which involve interviews, arrests, or subpoenas take place outside normal school hours.
