

5148-R Individual Religious Beliefs

- All activities, music, etc., may be seasonal in nature and characteristic of traditional practices.
- Any student or their family who feels that these programs violate their religious rights will present to the building administration evidence of such violation (a simple statement of fact will suffice).
- Any student who is deemed to be legitimately excused from participation will be given the choice of remaining in the class or being assigned to another area.
 - Any student so excluded will perform alternative assigned tasks and will not be penalized in any way for non-participation.
 - In the junior and senior high school elective classes, the student must participate in a major portion of the curriculum in order to receive credit. A course curriculum will be available prior to registration.
