

5158 Campbell County School District Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate from Campbell County School District (CCSD), students must meet the credit requirements as described in 5158-R.

CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

Chapter 31 of the Wyoming Department of Education Rules and Regulations requires that students successfully complete the following components in grades nine (9) through twelve (12), as evidenced by passing grades or by the successful performance on competency-based equivalency examinations: four (4) school years of English, three (3) school years of mathematics, three (3) school years of science, and three (3) school years of social studies including history, American government and economic systems and institutions.

CCSD secondary schools will determine minimum credit requirements that meet or exceed the minimum requirements as set forth in Chapter 31. These credit determinations will be approved by the CCSD Board of Trustees.

CCSD students will be assessed in the uniform student content and performance standards at the level set by the Board of Education in the following areas of knowledge and skills, emphasizing reading, writing, and mathematics in grades one (1) through eight (8).

The assessment system will meet the individual needs of CCSD in demonstrating whether or not students have mastered the common core of knowledge and skills as reflected in the uniform student content and performance standards as specified in Chapter 10 of the Wyoming Department of Education rules. The assessment system described in this section shall be designed for grades one (1) through twelve (12) and be aligned to the uniform state standards, both in terms of content and cognitive complexity.
