Wellness Representative Description:

Terms of Employment:

Appointed annually to serve during the school term.

Essential Job Requirements:

Wellness Committee Requirements

- 1- Attend Wellness meetings
- 2- Promote Wellness Programs and all relevant events.
- 3- Share ideas and opinions with other Representatives and Wellness Coordinator.
- 4- Contribute to activities and events throughout the year.
 - a. Coordinate POW-2 in your building (place/date)
 - b. Coordinate Blood Draw
 - c. Serve on subcommittee (1 of 2)
EX: Jingle Bell Run, Helping Hands

Building Requirements

- 1- Send emails to building staff as requested.
- 2- Wellness Programs
 - a. Keep up to date information.
 - b. Advertise within two days of request.
- 3- Reach out and continually engage staff in their building.
- 4- Communication
 - a. Speak at staff meetings to promote Wellness programs.
 - b. Seek out staff with promotion tools such as fliers.
 - c. Contact staff that does not use a computer.
 - d. Contact staff that work early or late shifts or do not attend staff meetings.
