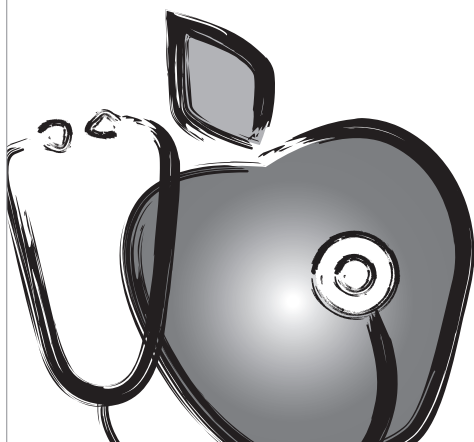
The Kid Clinic provides primary healthcare for infants and children up to 18 years old, helping parents establish a relationship for regular well child check-ups, ongoing healthcare, and any acute care needs.

Mental Health services are provided by licensed counselors and social workers for children ages 4-21.

The Kid Clinic accepts private insurance, Equality Care/Medicaid and KidCare/CHP. No child is denied services based solely on inability to pay.

The Kid Clinic is a collaboration between Campbell County Health (CCH) and Campbell County School District, part of CCH's system of care, which includes Campbell County Memorial Hospital and Campbell County Medical Group.

Open Monday-Friday from 8 am-12 pm and 1-5 pm with same day appointments available.
