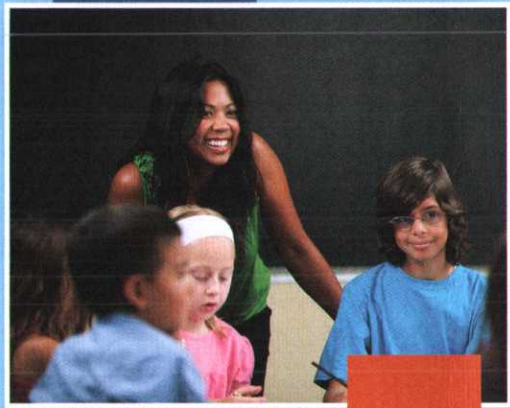

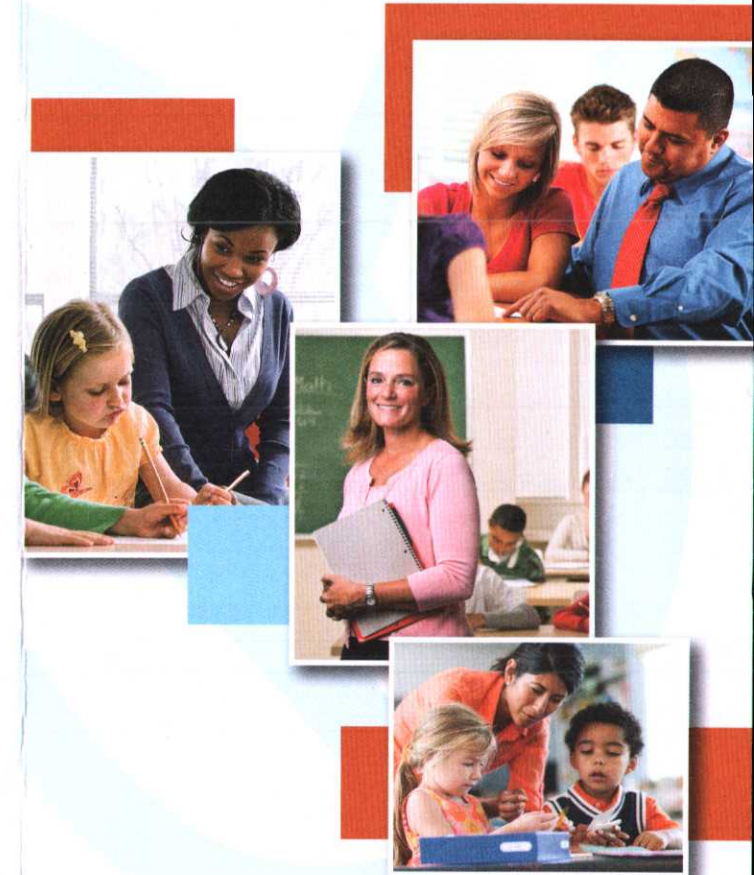

HONORING LEADERS IN EDUCATION

The Peabody Energy Leaders in Education program recognizes outstanding education professionals – principals, teachers, counselors, administrators and support staff – who make a difference in the lives of students in our communities.

Leaders in Education honorees are selected in qualifying school districts by a committee of top educators, community and corporate leaders who live in the region. Each recipient earns a \$1,000 grant that can be used any way the honoree wishes.

Winners automatically compete to be Peabody Energy's Educator of the Year. The winner receives an additional \$5,000 grant.
