South Campus Access

Dr. Ayers reviewed the City's final proposal for the access at South Campus. Mrs. Ochs made a motion to approve the plan, Mrs. Shippy seconded, and the motion carried.

Facilities Update

Dr. Ayers updated the trustees about School 3, which has been funded; Westwood High School, still under discussion with support from SFC; Stocktrail Elementary School, funds scheduled for demolition; and Lakeview Elementary School, funded for planning only, location and timing still under discussion.

Legislative Update

Dr. Ayers reviewed many legislative bills affecting education including Hathway scholarship, charter schools, athletic safety, the School Facilities Commission, education accountability, assessment, and finance recalculation. Dr. Fall expressed appreciation to the Campbell County Legislative Delegation for their efforts.
