CONSENT AGENDA ENDS

Staff Communicators' Assembly Presentations

ESP Co-Chairs Teri Gawronski and Larry Ferril presented three proposed options for salary increases for next year. Option 1 (the favored option) - allow one step on the existing salary schedule and to continue th 1.5% stipend for those "topped out." Option 2 - allow one step on the existing salary schedule, increase vacation days to two days per month for employees with more than 20 years of service and increase convenience days to 5 days per year for employees with more than 20 years of service. Option 3 - allow one step on the existing salary schedule.

Certified Co-Chairs Norm Silbaugh, Nick Gallagher, and Brian Brandon presented a proposal including district coverage of the increased Wyoming Retirement .25% contribution, allow one step movement on the salary schedule, and continued stipend of 1.5% for "topped out" employees.

Both groups were appreciative of assistance they received from administration and the Board's consideration of the requests.

Review of Value - Trust

Dr. Strahorn reviewed the final value - Trust: Relying upon and having confidence in our relationships and operations. He noted this value strongly guides our district and leads our staff.

Old Lakeview School Facility Disposal Options

Dr. Strahorn summarized options for the building including selling it; providing it to a community partner - city, county, hospital; keeping it for future use; or provide to a non-profit organization. In regard to the last option, Dr. Strahorn noted he has been approached by the City and Campbell County Boys and Girls Club with an interest in obtaining the building for the Club. Following discussion with the trustees, Dr. Strahorn was directed to move forward with the investigation of this possibility.

Bementary Music Proposal

Dr. Brown reviewed the current state of elementary music programs and the need for change at the Fifth and Sixth Grade level so student instructional time is preserved and increased while still offering instrumental music instruction. He reviewed a proposal in which instrumental music will continue to be part of the Fifth and Sixth Grade specials; Fifth and Sixth Grade students will choose to take either instrumental or general music which will be rotated with art and physical education; instrumental teachers will use classrooms if needed to accommodate band and strings classes; and music teams, including a general music teacher, will rotate to elementary schools on a three-day schedule. Several people in the audience made comments in support of continuing to offer music options at the elementary level including Maestro Norman Gamboa, Marie Dickey, Karen Gleason, Sue Hays, Nick Gallager, Erin Knutson, Brad Winter, Wendy Gray, Bin Mayo, Sonja Brue, Becky Safora, Jerry Orsman, Brian Knox. Following discussion by the Board, Dr. Fall made a motion to approve the proposal, Mrs. Ochs seconded, and the motion carried.

Facility Update

Dr. Ayers reviewed current projects including the New Lakeview project and the contractor, Groathouse Construction, which will be on site next week; Westwood High School which is moving on with a tight time frame for completion; Stocktrail demolition well underway; Rozet HVAC funding secured; capacity study impacts for South Campus and the need to request grade configuration changes to proceed; and investigation regarding the location of the next new elementary school and budgetary impacts.

With no other business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 10:30 p.m.
