Policy 5132, Student Appearance

Dr. Brown reviewed changes to the policy including allowing some discretion by building administrators to determine appropriateness of dress. Following discussion including the regulation, Dr. Lawrence called for the question. He then moved to approve the regulation with modifications suggested by Mrs. Ochs, Mrs. Ochs seconded, and the motion carried. Mrs. Hepp made a motion to approved the policy, Mrs. Ochs seconded, and the motion carried.

Budget Amendment Hearing

Mrs. Shippy recessed the regular meeting at 8:00 p.m. to receive public input regarding the proposed budget amendment which Dr. Ayers explained. There being no public input, the meeting was resumed at 8:10 p.m.

Chinese Language

Dr. Brown summarized discussion regarding the possibility of offering Mandarin Chinese as a high school class. He noted a committee has been formed and interest in attending the Chinese Bridge program is being probed. He will return with more information at a future board meeting.

Compass Learning Contract

Dr. Brown reviewed the contract, suggested to be purchased with ARRA funds. The program works well with MAP scores, would function as a intervention for math at the elementary level, and will be piloted at Sage Valley, Twin Spruce, and Wright Junior-Senior High schools. Mrs. Ochs made a motion to approve the contract, with changes suggested by Mr. Stevens regarding jurisdiction, in the amount of \$465,625 for elementary use and \$13,290 for the junior highs and Wright Junior-Senior High. Dr. Lawrence seconded, and the motion carried.

Regulation 4180-R, *Staff Development*

Dr. Ayers and Mrs. Carryl Goens, Director of Staff Development, explained discussion and work regarding incentives, text encouraging participation in professional development classes by all work groups, and proposed changes to the regulation. Mrs. Goens noted changes in the offers of Wellness classes as part of professional development. Mrs. Ochs made a motion to approve changes to the regulation, Mrs. Hepp seconded, and the motion carried.

Proposed Fiscal Management Policy 3101

Mr. Don Dihle, Supervisor of Fiscal Services, reviewed the proposed policy which is required by GASB 54 and supports a more consistent reporting of fund balances. Dr. Lawrence moved to approve the policy, Mrs. Hepp seconded, and the motion carried.

Budget Amendment

Mrs. Ochs moved to adopt the budget amendment resolution as follows, **WHEREAS** Campbell County School District Number One is a nonprofit political subdivision of the State of Wyoming formed to provide public education in grades K-12 for persons residing within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the General Fund 01 in the amount of \$1,025,000 to account for the employer share of the WY Retirement increase and the corresponding revenue from the State of Wyoming;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the General Fund 01 in the amount of \$2,668,124.16 to account for the rebated recapture bonus and operating transfer from Special Revenue Fund 23;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to adjust the General Fund 01 to account for budget journal entries during the fiscal year and to adjust contingency accounts including increasing function 2000 Instructional Support Services in the amount of \$125,000, increasing function 4000

Non-Instructional Services in the amount of \$20,000, and decreasing function 1000 Instruction Services in the amount of \$145,000;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to adjust the Building General Fund 02 to account for an operating transfers to the General Fund 01 in the amount of \$101,059.94 to meet GASB 54 Rules;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the General Fund 01 in the amount of \$221,550 to account for potential operating transfers to the Nutrition Services Fund 50 for two vans, a walk-in freezer, and a potential cash shortfall;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Nutrition Service Fund 50 in the amount of \$543,976.01 to account for increased revenue, food and insurance costs, and the operating transfers for two vans and a walk-in freezer;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Grants Special Revenue Fund 20 in the amount of \$3,941,020 to account for Ed Jobs, Bridges Summer School and various other grants received during the fiscal year;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to reclassify the 'K' Fund Special Revenue Fund 21 to 'K' Enterprise Fund 51 to comply with GASB 54 Rules and set the 'K' Enterprise Fund 51 budget at \$262,025.67; and

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Sick Leave Fund 70 in the amount of \$354,000 and reclassify the fund from a Special Revenue Fund to a General Fund 04 to comply with GASB 54 Rules and set the Fund 04 budget at \$51,000.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees, Campbell County School District Number One, Gillette, Wyoming, this 14th day of June, 2011, hereby approves the budget amendment as stated above. Mrs. Jennings seconded, and the motion carried.

With no other business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:13 p.m.
