Strategic Plan Monitoring Document	Dr. Strahorn reviewed the monitoring document including reports by Dr. Brown on Goal 1, Mr. Reznicek on Goal 2, and Dr. Ayers on Goal 3. The trustees requested goal progress reports three times per year. Various strategies to communicate the goals and progress to the community were discussed including parent newsletters, the district website, local newspapers, and staff communication. Mrs. Ochs moved to approve the document, Dr. Lawrence seconded, and the motion carried.
Capital for a Day	Dr. Strahorn shared an invitation for the board to participate in various activities on September 11 when Gillette will host state elected officials for Capital for a Day. As part of the events, Governor Mead will present the USDA Healthy Meals Silver Award to the District. Students have been asked to participate in various activities as well.
Smoke Free Gillette	Dr. Strahorn reviewed several options for the trustees' consideration including adoption of a resolution as suggested by the group, signing a letter of support, or designing our own resolution. Mrs. Jennings moved to support the resolution as submitted by Smoke Free Gillette and to sign the letter of support as read by Dr. Fall. Mrs. Durgin seconded, and the motion carried.
PAWS Results	Dr. Brown provided a report for the board regarding the most recent results. He discussed the AYP targets and reported that the targets were revised after the tests were completed and, as a result, more schools will likely fail AYP.
First Day Enrollment	Dr. Brown reported the total first day enrollment as 8,726 which is an additional 211 students over last year's enrollment and includes 848 kindergarteners.
Facilities Update	Dr. Ayers reported that Buffalo Ridge is open and the sand pile is gone. He also reported that the Westwood High School project is progressing with a contract established with MOA; the property for Lakeview Elementary is nearing close as well at the property purchase near CCHS North; the HVAC projects at the junior highs are going well; no architect has been chosen for the Stocktrail demolition but discussions are ongoing; and the fencing project at South Campus is nearing completion. He noted that the HVAC project for Rozet is progressing for work next year. Dr. Ayers noted that the district facility master plan was last completed in 2006 and might be need updating.

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	He said the recent capacity study done by the state suggests that the junior highs can accommodate quite a few more students than administration believes will fit comfortably in the schools and will likely need to be modified. Dr. Ayers reported that the county commission has requested the District consider setting aside about two acres for a fire station at the Enzi/Southern Drive property. By consensus the board directed Dr. Ayers to look into possibilities.
Executive Session	Dr. Strahorn requested an executive session to discuss litigation and personnel. Mrs. Hepp moved to recess to executive session, Mrs. Ochs seconded, and the motion carried at 8:45 p.m. Dr. Fall reconvened the meeting at 9:25 p.m.
Adjournment	With no other business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:25 p.m.
