Tennis Court Replacement with Change Order

Dr. Brown explained the changes and subsequent lowering of cost of the tennis court replacement and removal of Alternate 1. Following discussion, Mr. Pecha made a motion to approve the bid and changes to Hladky Construction in the amount of \$563,536.79.

Prairie Wind Elementary School Decisions

Dr. Brown asked Stocktrail Elementary Principal Kathy Quinn to explain the process and results of student voting for a mascot and colors for Prairie Wind Elementary. She noted that a contest was held and students chose Dust Devils as the mascot and chocolate brown and gold as the colors.
