The 2017 HB 1 JCC01 will be signed by the governor unless 2017 HB236 or 2017 SF 165 are enacted into law. The projected reduction in funding for Campbell County School District under 2017HB1 JCC01 is \$2,324,116.		
	Other bills discussed were SF36 which would require the superintendent's evaluation tool be approved by the state board of education, HB101 which allows for veteran preference in hiring, and HB 40 aligns the assessment system with ESSA. HB 137 and HB 194 contain legislation regarding guns in schools and public buildings.		
Personnel Update	Mr. Reznicek reviewed the process that has been followed in achieving the goals of transferring faculty to accommodate ninth grade students moving to the high school and transferring and hiring staff for the additional high school.
