CONSENT AGENDA ENDS

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Wyoming School Boards Association Resolution Dr. Brown presented a resolution for potential consideration by the Wyoming School Boards Delegate Assembly. Suicide Prevention Update Kip Farnum, Director of Student Support Services, and Jeff Rice with Behavioral Health Services provided a suicide prevention update and shared information regarding the programs and services provided through the District and Behavioral Health Services. Mr. Farnum stated that the District is in the process of updating the suicide prevention policy.

District Data Report

Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum, Assessment, and Staff Development, Kelly Hornby, provided district academic information. He also reviewed a new report format the schools will be using to report their academic information.

Facilities Report

Mr. Eisenhauer provided a facilities report. All summer projects were completed in time for there to be no disruption to the start of the school year. Currently maintenance is making sure all HVAC systems are operating properly so the systems are ready for the winter.

Mr. Eisenhauer attended a meeting of the Select Committee on School Facilities. He noted concerns with potential proposed legislation regarding changes in the major maintenance funding formula, major maintenance expenditure restrictions, and major maintenance payment schedule. Another concern is a potential requirement for districts to use a statewide school facilities system. Mr. Eisenhauer will keep the board updated on these matters.

Trustee Celebrations

Chairman Ochs commended Mr. Hornby and staff on the great work they did on the District Assessment System (DAS) which was presented to Wyoming Department of Education and received high praise.

Dr. Brown thanked Trustee Clouston for hosting a tailgate party before the CCHS and TBHS football game. Booster clubs from both schools attended the event and raised about \$500 for the booster clubs.
