Wyoming Statute 21-2-132

Mr. Eisenhauer introduced Police Chief Jim Hloucal and Under Sheriff Quentin Reynolds who provided information for discussion regarding Wyoming Statute 21-2-132, Possession of Firearms on School Property. Police and sheriff departments have offered to provide firearms training to six school district employees this summer. This training will provide an opportunity to get a feel for the training that would be required if the board decides to move in this direction. Public hearings will be held prior to the board making a decision on this matter.

Lightning Prediction System

Mr. Eisenhauer updated the board on the lightning prediction system. A quote has been received in the amount of \$98,000, and the Campbell County Community Recreation Department Board approved a grant for the project in the amount of the quote. Mr. Eisenhauer stated that the City and County are on board with the project, and training will be provided on use of the system. The system will also be available in Wright; however, the exact location has not been determined.
