- Additions or Deletions A request was made to add an appointment to the Community Behavioral Health Committee under the appointment section of the agenda. Appointments were made before recessing for the budget amendment hearing.
- Board Appointments A motion was made by Mrs. Durgin and seconded by Mr. Foreman to appoint Dr. Clouston to the Campbell County Community Public Recreation District Board and Dr. Lawrence to the Community Behavioral Health Committee. The motion carried unanimously.
- Budget Amendment Hearing Chairman Ochs recessed the regular board meeting at 6:36 PM to hold a budget amendment hearing. The budget amendment was reviewed by Mr. Holmes and Mrs. Haney. There being no public input, the budget amendment hearing adjourned; and the regular meeting reconvened at 6:44 PM.
- Budget Amendment Resolution Mr. Foreman made a motion to approve the following budget amendment. Mrs. Durgin seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
- WHEREAS** Campbell County School District Number One is a nonprofit political subdivision of the State of Wyoming formed to provide public education in grades K-12 for persons residing within its boundaries;
- WHEREAS** the Board of Trustees wishes to reduce Sick Leave Reimbursement Fund 04 in the amount of \$5,127.24, reduce Recreation Grants Special Revenue Fund 25 in the amount of \$33,510.55, and reduce Recreation Grants Capital Projects Fund 34 in the amount of \$205,886.17, to bring the budgets in line with the adjusted fund balances;
- WHEREAS** the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the General Fund 01 in the amount of \$14,890,000 to account for the purchase of ten additional buses totaling \$990,000, a potential operating transfer to Nutrition Services Fund 50 not to exceed \$900,000 for equipment purchases and cash shortfall, and a potential operating transfer to the Depreciation Fund 31 not to exceed \$13,000,000 to fund projects such as Technology, STEM Labs, Facilities-Aquatic Center & CCHS Soccer Field, and Security;
- WHEREAS** the Board of Trustees wishes to increase Nutrition Services Fund 50 in the amount of \$100,000 to account for additional transfers from General Fund 01;
- WHEREAS** the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Depreciation Fund 31 in the amount of \$2,000,000 for projects such as the CCHS Soccer Field and STEM Labs;
- WHEREAS** the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Building General Fund 02 in the amount of \$1,420.12 to bring the budget in line with the adjusted fund balance and close out the fund;
- WHEREAS** the Board of Trustees wishes to increase Major Maintenance Fund 22 in the amount of \$500,000 to account for major maintenance projects; and
- WHEREAS** the Board of Trustees wishes to adjust all General Funds to account for budget journal entries and minor operating transfers throughout the fiscal year, as well as adjusting contingency accounts to meet the needs of the District.
- BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** that the Board of Trustees, Campbell County School District Number One, Gillette, Wyoming, this 11th day of June, 2019, hereby approves the budget amendment as stated above.

Graduation Rates and ACT Preparation

High school principals Chad Bourgeois, Gib Ostheimer, and Kelly Morehead updated the board regarding graduation rates and ACT preparation efforts. Students were given a practice ACT test this last school year to help them with stamina and content knowledge. Going forward, the principals plan to allow more time between the practice test and the actual ACT test in an effort to address areas where students can improve. Increased interventions within the school day are also planned for next year.

Graduation rates are growing, and principals shared they are working toward growing a culture where students are proud to graduate. Also attempts are being made to encourage a culture where learning is a guarantee rather than an opportunity.

Mr. Foreman made a motion to approve the EMS recommendation to change the job title of Administrative Assistant to the Associate Superintendent for Instructional Support to Finance Specialist/Administrative Assistant to the Associate Superintendent for Instructional Support and move the position from Salaried Range 5 to Salaried Range 6. Mrs. Bell seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously. Mr. Foreman made a motion to approve the EMS recommendation to move the job titled Assistant Human Resources Manager from Supervisor/Manager Range 3 to Supervisor/Manager Range 6. Mrs. Bell seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.
