Safety Sensitive Bus Routes

Bus Routes 31, 33, 34, 64, 84, 85, 90, 91, 94, 123, 124, and 125 were approved for safety sensitive issues due to a physical barrier that would prevent a student from safely walking to school or a safety hazard that could cause the student harm. Routes recommended other than certain maintained streets and roads were approved including Routes 13, 16, 23, 25, 27, 39, 42, 56, 58, 65, and 66. A request to waive requirements as allowed under W.S. § 31-5-507 to actuate red visual signals within school designated bus loading zones was approved.
