- Budget Amendment Hearing Chairman Ochs recessed the regular board meeting at 6:11 PM to hold a budget amendment hearing. Mr. Holmes and Mrs. Haney reviewed the budget amendment. There being no public input, the budget amendment hearing adjourned, and Chairman Ochs reconvened the regular meeting at 6:14 PM.
- Budget Amendment Resolution Dr. Lawrence made a motion to approve the following budget amendment. Mrs. Durgin seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.

WHEREAS Campbell County School District Number One is a nonprofit political subdivision of the State of Wyoming formed to provide public education in grades K-12 for persons residing within its boundaries;
WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Depreciation Fund 31 in the amount of \$13,618,000 and increase the General Fund 01 by \$3,618,000 for a potential operating transfer from the General Fund 01 to the Depreciation Fund 31 for projects including Equipment Replacement, Aquatic Center Replacement, and Security Projects;
WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to increase the Nutrition Services Fund 50 in the amount of \$503,651.08 for increased revenues and expenses due to operating under the Summer Food Program, as well as rising food and material costs;
WHEREAS the Board of Trustees wishes to adjust all General Funds to account for budget journal entries and minor operating transfers throughout the fiscal year, as well as adjusting contingency accounts to meet the needs of the District.
BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees, Campbell County School District Number One, Gillette, Wyoming, this 14th day of June, 2022, hereby approves the budget amendment as stated above.

The motion carried unanimously.</p>
Girls Wrestling	<p>Dr. Ayers provided information and asked for approval to add girls wrestling to the wrestling programs at the high school level for the 2022-2023 school year. In April, the Wyoming High School Activities Association (WHSAA) sanctioned girls wrestling in Wyoming. The new program will create a classification for girls to compete against one another, although they will continue to be a part of the boy's wrestling team, similar to</p>

track and cross country. The girl's team will have a bracket at the state wrestling tournament on February 23, 2024. No additional coaches will be needed, and funding will be minimal. The range movement will be reevaluated next spring along with the emergency pay movement of bus driving positions; move Computer Systems Analyst to ESP Salary Non-Exempt Pay Range 4; move ESL Teacher Assistant to ESP Hourly Pay Range 8; move Lead Person-General Department to ESP Hourly Range 26; move Lead Person-Skilled Maintenance Crafts, Furniture and Grounds to ESP Hourly Range 26; move Nutrition Services Production Manager to ESP Hourly Pay Range 18, move Warehouse Technician to ESP Hourly Range 14. Dr. Lawrence made a motion to approve the recommendations from Educational Management Solutions (EMS). Mr. Steiger seconded the motion, and the motion carried unanimously.
